Students will:

1. Always sign in through Clever and check their student email daily before school starts

3. Know and follow daily schedule
4. Complete work before due date, whether for online or in-person classes
5. Submit assignments on or before due date
6. Self-advocate: Reach out and ask about anything you don't understand – we are here to help you

Parent/Guardian will:

1. For online learners, obtain a laptop (personal or Valencia) and ensure internet connectivity (Cox, Comcast, etc). If unable, request assistance from Valencia.
2. Supply materials for student (paper, pens/pencils, binder/folder). If unable, request materials from Valencia.
3. Provide a quiet learning space for “classwork” to take place, especially during virtual meetings
4. Encourage student to stay on daily school routine; to attend virtual meetings; to complete work; and to self-advocate if struggling on a concept
5. Be an advocate for your child’s mental health; check in on them, be encouraging and supportive
6. Check ParentVUE at least twice a week for updates, teacher communication, resources, and student grades/attendance.
7. Provide updated and accurate contact information to Valencia.
